### **Is the training for medical personnel available throughout the United States?**

Yes, The training is available in English and is web-based. It's called the Curriculum in IDD Healthcare. It consists of 6 eLearn modules and includes CME credit for physicians and CEU credit for nurses. ### **Are there specific symptoms or illnesses that require a different treatment than non IDD people presenting the same symptoms?**

There are a number of health conditions that present differently in people with IDD that they do in those without it. Some people who have difficulty communicating with words may indicate pain of illness through behaviors. Sometimes these behaviors are thought to be "just because the person has a disability," however many can point to specific underlying conditions.
